

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Literacy Update – Louise





- **Poetry Revision**: Mondays during DEAR (Drop Everything and Read).


We encourage all Year 11 students to take advantage of these sessions to enhance their preparation for the exams.





SCIENCE UPDATES



- Registration Deadline: April 9, 2025


The competition will feature **different levels** to suit participants' abilities. Please choose the appropriate level for your child. **Important Notes:**








SSS Geography Update – Miss Coy

Our French and Spanish Y11 students are revising key grammar, vocabulary and exam skills ahead of January mock examinations.


Meanwhile our other students are continuing their hard work with the grasp of new grammar rules and vocabulary in this weeks' classes.

PE Update Mr. Bladen


