
Year 10 students are starting the year by investigating how light intensity affects the rate of photosynthesis. Using experiments with aquatic plants, they measure oxygen production under different light conditions to understand the link between light and photosynthetic activity.



Meanwhile, Year 12 Biology students have explored membrane properties by examining how temperature impacts membrane permeability.




