Another excellent week at South View School filled with thrilling learning experiences in English, Maths, and Science. As we approach the GL tests, another gentle reminder to please make sure students bring their laptops, chargers, and headphones to school each day. Let's keep them prepared and ready for success!

This week at our primary school has been full of exciting achievements in English! Year 1 co continued to delve into their topic "Bright Lights, Big City," focusing on the proper use of capital letters in writing. Year 2 explored recount writing, skillfully applying conjunctions and commas to enhance their narratives. Year 4 students planned and executed their hot write, crafting detailed biographies on Julius Caesar. Year 5 took on the role of journalists, creating captivating newspaper articles about the discovery of Cleopatra's tomb in Damac Lagoons. Our students continue to impress us with their hard work and creativity. Well done to all for a fantastic week of learning!

This week in maths, our little stars in FS1 delved into understanding numbers up to 5, while FS2 mastered those crucial number bonds to 10. Year 1 embarked on a coin quest, getting to know their British currency, and Year 2 learned to tell time to the nearest 5 minutes. Year 3 reinforced their maths muscles by revisiting previous units, while Year 4 hunted down all sorts of 2D shapes. Meanwhile, Year 5 added and subtracted decimal numbers like pros, focusing on those sneaky decimal places. Our Year 6 leaders tackled the same challenge, honing their skills in decimal operations with confidence. Keep up the amazing work, everyone!

In science lessons this week our younger children in Year 2 have been getting their hands messy making Ooblik, which is a mixture of corn flour, water food colouring. The children made some excellent observations deciding whether what they made was solid or liquid, or could it possibly be both? In KS2, the children have been actively revising and consolidating scientific investigations from this and previous years in time for end of year recap and assessments.
