Students learn various skills and strategies through these games, including hand-eye coordination, teamwork, strategic thinking, and fair play. It's not just about physical abilities but also about understanding the rules and tactics to outsmart the opposing team.

As a learning support tool we encourage all of our learners to utilise the Atom online portal. Your child has a log in for the platform from their class teacher. They have assigned curriculum tasks to complete that incorporate English, maths and science. If you are unable to complete at home there is opportunity for your child to complete in school.

Throughout this week, our primary learners have busy recapping their term 1 learning in a variety of engaging and exciting ways.

In science lessons in Key Stage 1, our young learners were talking about their Science Day activities with their classes and celebrating their learning with peers. There are some excellent entries across all key phases included in the highlight reel below.

In Year 6, the children displayed their STEAM activities in the STEAM lab with many parents visiting school and sharing in their children's learning journey. There have been other exciting activities in Year 3 in where the children have been completing their focus on Rocks and Soils by explaining properties of rocks found here in the UAE. Year 4 were recently in their trip discovering more about teeth and the digestive system, most of the children even had the experience of sitting in a large mouth model to test their knowledge of teeth! In English lessons in FS and KS1 this week, children have been working hard to rehearse their story maps and have even begun innovating. In FS2 this week, children have been innovating their story and drawing a new story map using exciting, vibrant pictures. In year 2 and 3, students have enjoyed rehearsing their story maps using a range of creative actions! Year 2 children have been practicing using their phonics knowledge to decode words and have been answering a range of comprehension questions about their text, Jim and the Beanstalk. Children who completed the Read and Run marathon were very excited to receive their certificates, well done and very well deserved!

In maths, EYFS have been learning all about 2D shapes and counting their sides and corners as well as creating their own 2D shapes as a challenge! Year 3 have been learning all about inverse operations and have been working hard to estimate the answer first. We have wrapped up an amazing month of Barvember with the last of our workshops. The children have all worked so hard at using bar models to visualise their maths tasks and word problems! We have covered the quad in chalk during problem-solving...shh! Don't tell anyone!
