Enrolment Procedure




We're thrilled to share an update on our successful University Fair that was held this morning at South View.

Arabic Update

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We hope this message finds you in good health and spirits. We are excited to share with you a new and exciting initiative that has been implemented in the Secondary Department of our school, and we hope you will join us in supporting it and encouraging your sons and daughters to participate as well.

This initiative is called "Read and Win," and it aims to enhance our students' reading skills. We all know the importance of reading in expanding our students' horizons and increasing their knowledge. That's why we want to encourage our students to engage in daily, high-quality reading based on specific criteria.

How does the initiative work?

- Using the vocaroo website, each student will record their selves reading any Arabic story they like.
- Students will then submit the link or the QR code on teams.
- If students maintained daily reading for 6 days with no breaks, they earn merits based on how many weeks of reading they have completed. 1 month of daily reading equals 20 merits and a prize.
- Reading weeks start every Sunday and end on Friday. If a student broke the reading streak for the week, they have to start over on the coming Sunday.
- We believe that this initiative will be a wonderful opportunity for your children to develop their reading skills and foster a love for reading. We invite you to encourage your children to participate in this initiative and to follow their progress regularly.




Geography Year 11 – Fieldwork Trip and Masterclass
