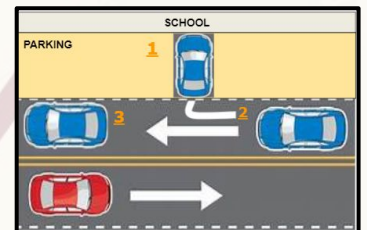
Drop-off

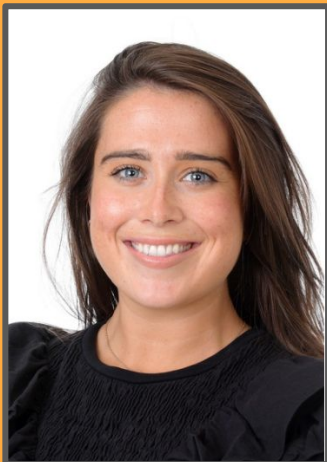
