I am excited to announce that this year we will be using an interactive reading app called 'Boom Reader' to log home reading for years 3 - 6. Children have had their accounts set up this week, so we are now ready to go!

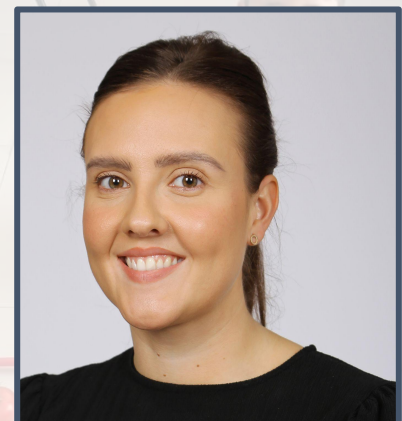

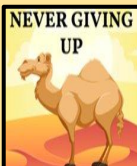
Miss Ruse's Highlight of the Week

What a fantastic week! In phonics, we have continued exploring our single sounds and learning how to form the letters. The children have been making fantastic links this week, by spotting the sounds in the classroom. We have also been very busy with our key texts this week, as we have started creating a story map and retelling the stories. The children have become completely immersed in the stories and loved suggesting their own signs for the key events, characters and vocabulary. In maths, we have continued to explore shapes, and introduced some important 3D shapes. We have been using lots of critical thinking by using the shapes to make pictures. The children explained and even justified why they chose the shapes they did to represent their pictures.

We also enjoyed raising awareness about dyslexia and created absolutely beautiful class butterflies.

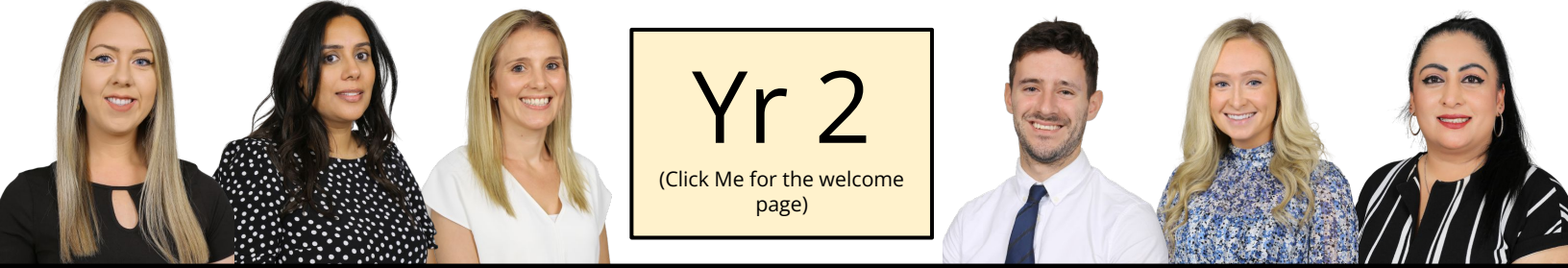

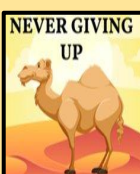
Miss O'Connor's Highlight of the Week

In MSC, we discussed the importance of persistence and resilience. We also examined how we take responsibility for ourselves and towards others at home and in school.

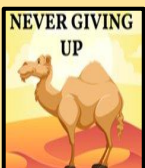
During Science, we investigated how fossils are formed and how they are a valuable source of information about the evolution of species.


