## **PE and Swimming**

PE and swimming are back!!

In EYFS and KS1 we have started the topic – PE ABCs and PE fundamentals where we are going to develop routines, introducing lesson rules and procedures. Students have been learning different ways of travelling, stop on command activities and tag games. In KS2 all students participated in the Beep Test, a multistage fitness test, it is a running test used to estimate a person's aerobic capacity.

#### Swimming:

Baselines assessment are done and now students have been organised into groups of level of ability.

We still have a few students that are not bringing the proper kit to PE and swimming. A gentle reminder that on PE and swimming days students must use their PE kit with proper shoe trainers .On swimming days students should also bring their swim suit/swim shorts under their PE kit and swimming cap, googles, flip-flops and towel inside of a swimming bag.
