Following announcements made by the UAE Government yesterday, **Sunday 2 January 2022** is now a **public holiday**.

The school will open on Monday 3 January 2022 with gates opening at 0725 hrs as normal.

From 3 January 2022, the new working week for the UAE and for SVS will be from Monday to Friday. The fundamental structure of the timetable will not change but it will be amended to incorporate the new working week and hours of operation. Updates and details of drop off and pick up arrangements will be sent out to all parents via SeeSaw and email prior to session start.



From Monday 3rd January, can we ask that parents ensure their SVS Yellow Lanyards are worn at all times, and the students wear their RFID card Blue lanyards at all times.

If parents forget their lanyard, they will need their Emirates ID to sign in for a visitor's pass.


Mr. Kerba's Highlight of the Week

Dear Parents of children in Years 3-6,

In order to ensure that we maintain a safe and responsible approach to the use of technology at SVS and in accordance with sound educational practice, it is necessary that all parents sign and agree to the following key documents:

- 1) Acceptable Use Policy (AUP): This explains and lays down the criteria for using ICT facilities at SVS and is geared to ensure equal access as well as smooth and appropriate use. It aims to ensure an understanding of the use of technology and guard against uses that may cause upset or damage to individuals, groups or the school.
- 2) Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Policy: This is necessary for anyone wishing to use their own device(s) in school or connect to the school's ICT infrastructure. Similar to the AUP, it clearly lays down how devices should and should not be used in order to ensure safe access and positive use. It also explains what needs to be done technically to ensure that the device user complies with usage safety regulations and is able to ensure a high level of safety integrity for their device.

As both of these documents relate directly to the school's Safeguarding and Child Protection Policy, are included in the inspection framework and are globally regarded as baseline requirements for school operations, your support in signing and returning these agreements is greatly appreciated.
