Highlights from around the Phase

We have had a fantastic week of learning where the children have explored so many new things this week. In Phonics, we learned a new sound 'p' and can name different things that start with that letter. We also looked at patterns in Maths and we could make 2 colour patterns on our own. FS1B have continued to look at different life cycles and this week explored plants. We learned about the different parts of a plant and we were so excited to plant our own seeds. FS1B are looking forward to being responsible for each of their plants and watching them grow over the rest of the term.





We have had lots of fun in FS2 this week, learning about length, continuing our phonics learning, and learning about solids and liquids. In Maths, we hunted for 'sea snakes' and made our own playdough sea snakes to measure using cubes! We practised identifying who had made the longest and shortest sea snake.

I think the highlight of the week in FS2E was our science experiment! We mixed cornflour and water to create oobelck, which was lots of fun to play in. After this, we used scientific vocabulary to identify that oobleck is in fact both a solid and a liquid.
