Mr. Holliday's Highlight of the Week

Following receipt of a confirmation by KHDA, I am very pleased to confirm that South View School will return to in-school, face-to-face learning from Monday 17 January 2022 for all children. Whilst the situation in respect of operations and student safety will be monitored and it is still possible that a further period of distance learning could take place in future, it is hoped that this return will be for the long term. To avoid the risk of spread and subsequent class closures, families with children showing symptoms of COVID-19 are encouraged to take a PCR test and wait for a negative result before returning to the school site.

KHDA have communicated that restrictions for PE, Swimming, ECAs and trips will remain in place and will be reviewed towards the end of January. You can read more on the <u>PE and</u> **House Teams** page.



When on school premises, can we ask that parents ensure their SVS Yellow Lanyards are worn at all times, and the students wear their RFID card Blue lanyards at all times.

In response <mark>t</mark>o the revised timetable, we have been able to make some developments to the delivery of Arabic A and Arabic B in the Primary School.

From 17th January onwards, we will be operating within the same Distance Learning guidelines as in Term 1. These are in line with the rules stipulated by the KHDA. A student will only qualify for Distance Learning if they fall into one of the below categories:

- 1. A DHA medical certificate is provided showing a child cannot engage in face to face learning (this is **not** for when a child is off school for a short term illness, this would be if a long term condition compromises a child's immune system or requires long term absence from school)
- 2. They are unable to travel from another country due to
 - international travel restrictions
- 3. They have been identified as a close contact or have CV19


With the new Omicron variant, we understand that the threat of Covid-19 is not waning soon. We would like to remind our student and parent body to continue being cautious and follow the Covid safety protocols. As per the last update for DHA guidelines, **the guarantine period after being tested positive**

for Covid is 10 days. This is counted from the day you have given sample for testing. Post completion of 10 days quarantine and receiving clearance certificate from DHA, you are good to join back school.

In case you are a close contact – **(spending more than 15 minutes within 1 metre range of a positive case)**, the quarantine period is 7 days. During this period, if you start to show symptoms of Covid-19, you will be required to undergo a PCR test. In case you show no symptoms, you can return to school.


Miss Stanton's Highlight of the Week
