EYFS Updates and Highlights

When I have wandered in and out of the EYFS classrooms this week I am, as I always am with the Early Years, struck by the curious nature of the children at SVS. The curiosity approach is an approach to early years education that focuses on nurturing children's natural curiosity and love of learning. It encourages children to explore, investigate and discover their environment, and to develop their creativity and imagination through play.

At the heart of the curiosity approach is the belief that children learn best when they are engaged and motivated, and when their learning is relevant to their interests and experiences. The approach encourages teachers to provide a rich and stimulating environment that is filled with open-ended resources and materials that children can use in a variety of ways. It really values the role of the adult in supporting children's learning, and encourages teachers to be responsive and attentive to children's interests and needs, so that they are facilitators of learning, rather than simply providers of knowledge.

I think our team in the EYFS have mastered this, it is an approach that requires a great deal of forethought and discussion and it is a pleasure to see this delivered so well in this fantastic department.

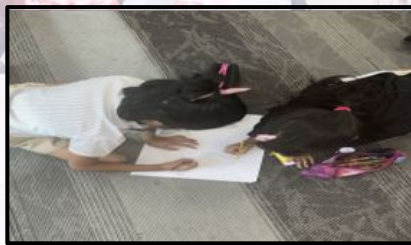

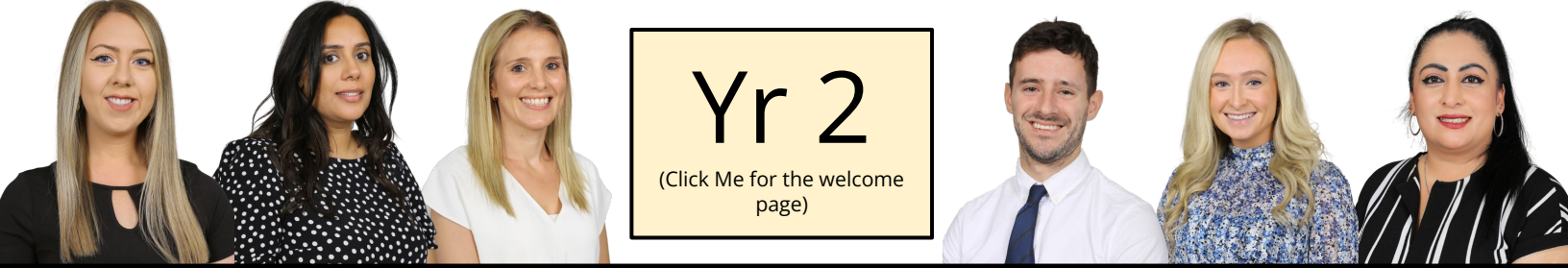
