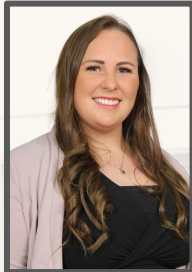

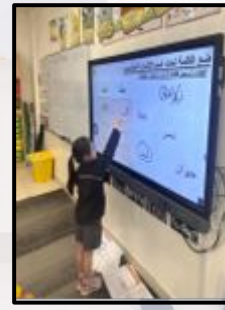

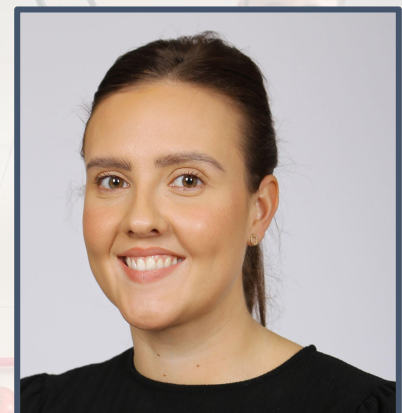

Miss Walker's Highlight of the Week

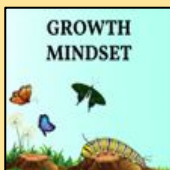

We have had another busy week in Year 1 that has come to a conclusion with some wonderful International Day celebrations.

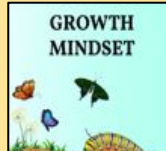
The children had a great time visiting all of the different stalls, trying lots of yummy, new foods, and getting a mini taste of the cultures of other countries.

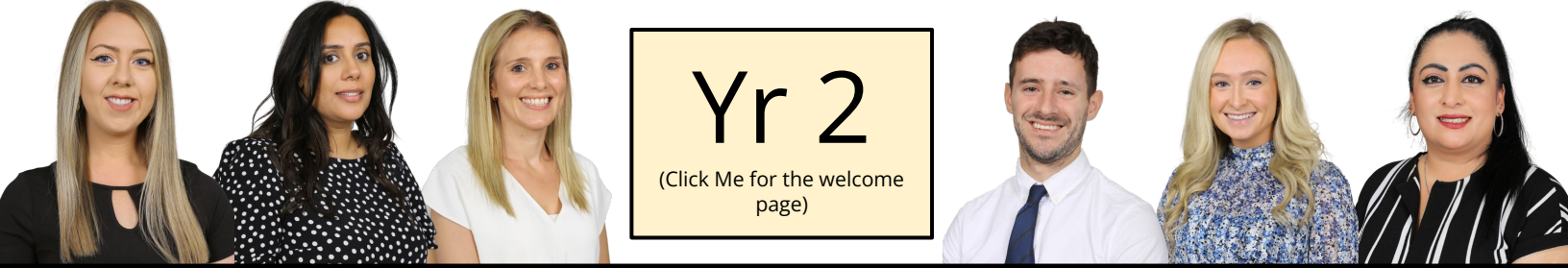

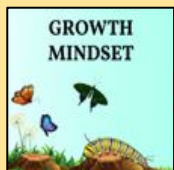

Miss O'Connor's Highlight of the Week

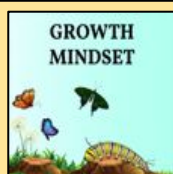

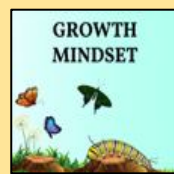
We ended the week with an enjoyable International day, learning about different countries that our classmates call home.

In Maths, we have started studying algebra with pupils being introduced to function machines and simple formulae.

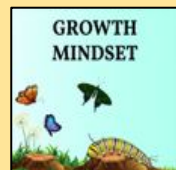
In Writing, pupils have continued to explore Explanation texts and have started creating PowerPoints to present for spy gadgets they have created.
