


With the new Omicron variant, we understand that the threat of Covid-19 is not waning soon. We would like to remind our student and parent body to continue being cautious and follow the Covid safety protocols.

As per the last update for DHA guidelines, <u>the quarantine period after being tested positive</u> <u>for Covid is 10 days</u>. This is counted from the day you have given sample for testing. Post completion of 10 days quarantine and receiving clearance certificate from DHA, you are good to join back school.

In case you are a close contact – **(spending more than 15 minutes within 1 metre range of a positive case)**, the quarantine period is 7 days. During this period, if you start to show symptoms of Covid-19, you will be required to undergo a PCR test. In case you show no symptoms, you can return to school.


Miss Stanton's Highlight of the Week
