- A transformed EYFS outdoor learning area, designed by Mrs. Patton, Teachers and SVS kids!



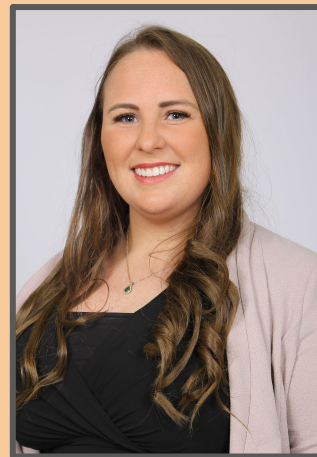


EYFS Updates and Highlights

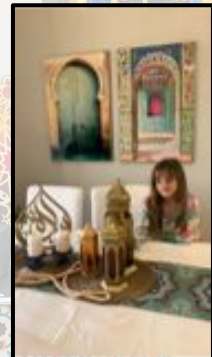

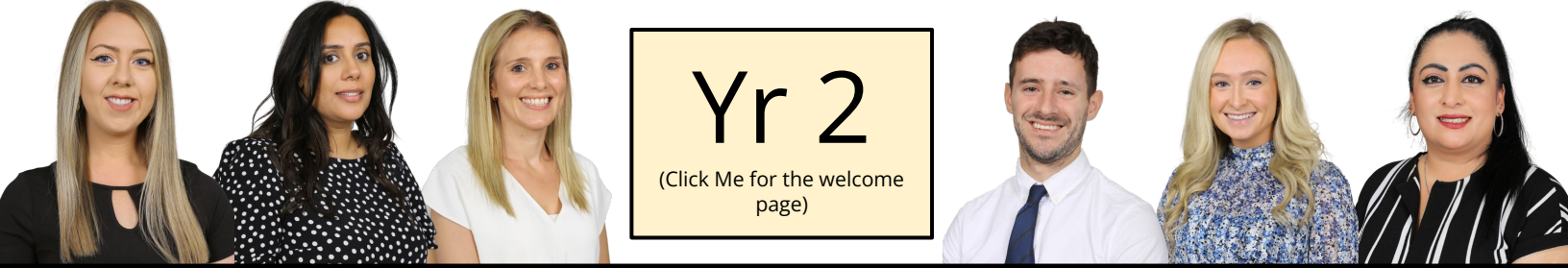

Another fantastic week in year 3!

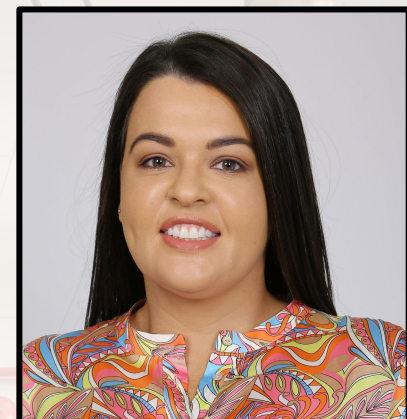
As we come to end end of yet another term it is lovely to reflect back on the last five weeks learning.
