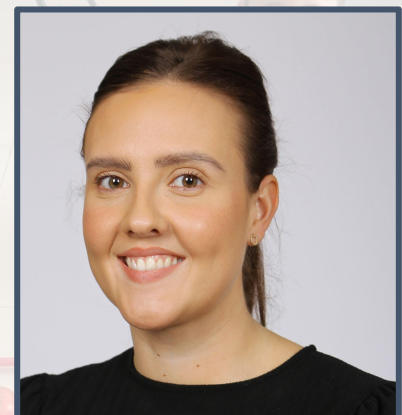

Miss Walker's Highlight of the Week

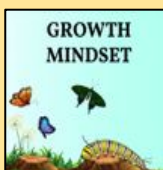

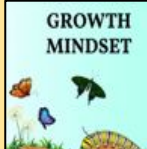
Miss Dye's Highlight of the Week

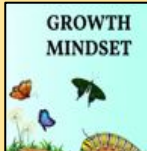

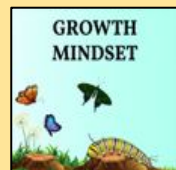

We have continued to work on our innovated persuasive leaflet in writing and are almost ready to innovate for our term 2.B hot write.

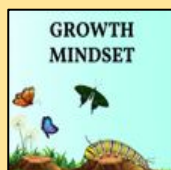
In Maths, students have started our new unit of Fractions, focusing on multiplying fractions by an integer.

In mathematics this week, we have continued developing our skills in algebra by creating formulae and equations with the help of practical resources.

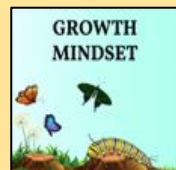
During our writing lessons, we have been innovated explanation texts in preparation for our Hot Write.
