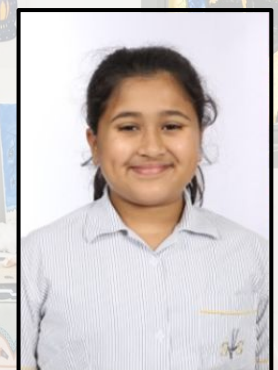
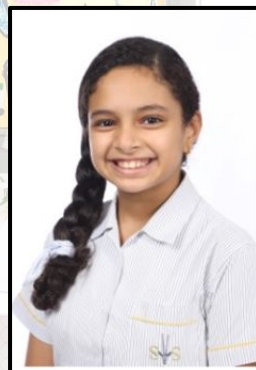
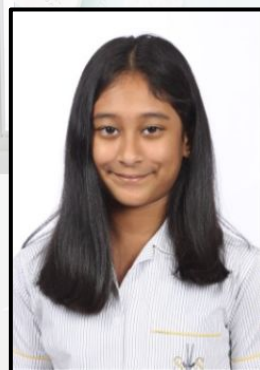

We were very impressed with the language the children used to compare the dinosaurs. They identified the key features of their animals and used these features to compare their dinosaurs. In maths, we have continued to explore subtraction. The children showed off their critical thinking skills by finding different ways to solve the problems. In science, we learnt how to create observational drawings and made a great first attempt at drawing crocodiles by identifying key features. On Tuesday, it is FS2's turns to fill the fridge.
