I am delighted to share with you a wide range of trips that South View School are hoping to host at the end of January/beginning of February.

These trips will vary from residential in RAK to flights to Oman, Azerbaijan, Sri Lanka, Nepal, USA and Thailand.

Primary children (current year 5) will have their residential in December whilst the secondary children (current year 6 and above) will have the option of a 3-night/4-day residential at the beginning of February.

For the first time ever, our international trips will be open to Year 6 and above and will all depart around the same time, end of January and through the first week of February.

- Azerbaijan ski trip – open to Y6 to Y11 (current Y5 to Y10)
- Oman adventure trip – open to Y6 to Y11 (current Y5 to Y10)
- Sri Lanka adventure, culture and service trip – open to Y6 to Y11 (current Y5 to Y10)

- USA will be a science-based trip to NASA and will be open to Y7 to Y11 (current Y6 to Y10)

Message from the Science team

This week, our Triple Year 10 Chemistry students were put to the test in a battle against speed, accuracy, and critical thinking. With no more than a 35-minute time limit and various equipment, students had to independently determine their own method to produce the purest samples of sodium chloride. Students quickly concluded the best method was to titrate hydrochloric acid against sodium hydroxide to produce aqueous sodium chloride. They then evaporated the water using Bunsen burners to leave solid sodium chloride crystals which were then tested for purity using universal indicator.
