

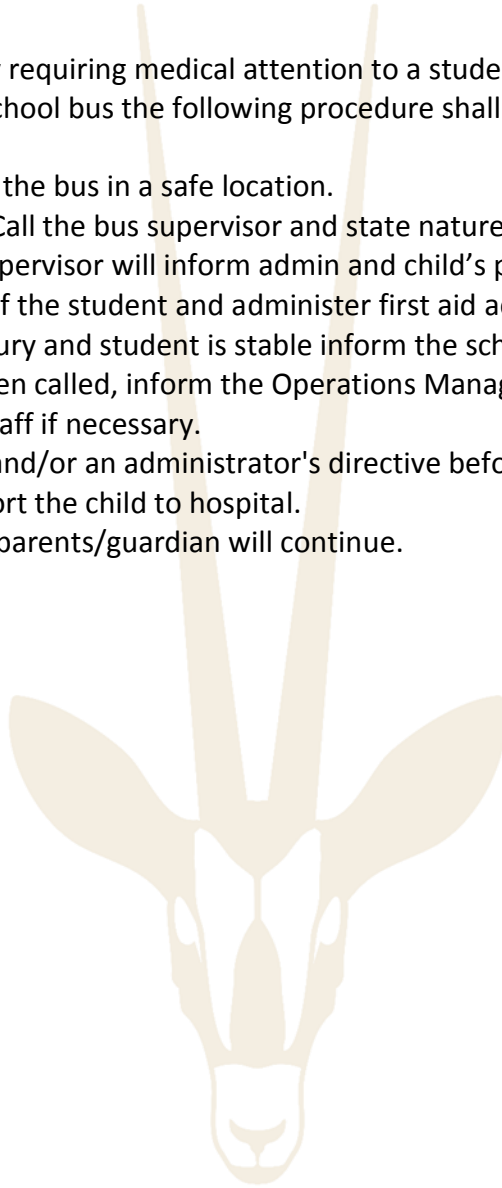
Medical Emergency on the School Bus

AIM

This policy is intended to address emergency medical procedures relating to the transportation of students.

In the event of an emergency requiring medical attention to a student that might result in the need for EMS services on a school bus the following procedure shall be used:

1. Ask the driver to stop the bus in a safe location.
2. Assess the situation. Call the bus supervisor and state nature of situation. Call 998 if necessary. The bus supervisor will inform admin and child's parent.
3. Attend to the needs of the student and administer first aid according to your ability. If there is no serious injury and student is stable inform the school.
4. If ambulance have been called, inform the Operations Manager or Bus Supervisor. Request for backup staff if necessary.
5. Wait for EMS, police and/or an administrator's directive before moving bus. The bus attendant should escort the child to hospital.
6. Efforts to update the parents/guardian will continue.
